BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 92-7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
- 3 "(b) No less than six calendar days prior to the meeting,
- 4 the board shall post the notice on an electronic calendar on a
- 5 website maintained by the State or the appropriate county and in
- 6 the board's office for public inspection. The notice shall also
- 7 be posted at the site of the meeting whenever feasible. The
- 8 board shall provide a copy of the notice to the office of the
- 9 lieutenant governor or the appropriate county clerk's office at
- 10 the time the notice is posted, and the office of the lieutenant
- 11 governor or the appropriate clerk's office shall post paper or
- 12 electronic copies of all meeting notices in a central location
- in a public building; provided that a failure to do so by the
- 14 board, the office of the lieutenant governor, or the appropriate
- 15 county clerk's office shall not require cancellation of the
- 16 meeting. The copy of the notice to be filed with the office of
- 17 the lieutenant governor or the appropriate county clerk's office
