HB 2298, HD1 (SSCR2919) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO NOTICE TO CHILDREN PURSUANT TO THE CHILD PROTECTIVE ACT. Provides that a summons under the Child Protective Act shall be served upon all parties, except the child, after petition has been filed. Requires the petitioner to notify the child of a hearing no less than 24 hours prior to a temporary foster custody hearing or no less than 48 hours prior to any other hearing. (HB2298 HD1)	HMS, JDL
<u>SCR 41</u> (SSCR2954)Status & Testimony	REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION AND DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES TO ASSIST WITH INCREASING VOTER REGISTRATION AMONG YOUNG ADULTS.	EDU/HMS, JDL
