Measure Title: RELATING TO THE UNIFORM INFORMATION PRACTICES ACT (MODIFIED).

Report Title: Uniform Information Practices Act

Description: Allows government agencies to withhold personal information contained in final opinions or orders made in the adjudication of cases where the disclosure of the information would be an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. Excludes social security number information of an individual under contract with the government from disclosure. (HB553 CD1)
