Measure Title: RELATING TO PUBLIC MEETINGS.

Report Title: Public Meetings

Description: Allows two members of a board to discuss between themselves matters relating to official board business if the two members do not constitute a quorum of their board. Provides that final actions taken in violation of open meeting and public notice requirements may be voidable upon proof of violation. (HB551 CD1)
